
## Travel directions to Cenex

Cenex is located in the Holywell Building on Holywell Park at the Loughborough University campus (West Side). All visitors should report to security on arrival, please let them know you are visiting the Cenex office in the Holywell Building. (Car parking fees apply, please see page 2 for more details).

### By road

Loughborough University Science and Enterprise Park is easily accessible from the M1 (Junction 23) or the A6 and is situated on the west side of the Loughborough University campus. On leaving the M1 motorway, head towards Loughborough town centre (A512). At the second major roundabout, turn right and report to security. You will then be directed straight towards the Holywell Car Park. Once parked, follow the signs to Holywell Building/Cenex.



#### By rail

Loughborough Train Station is located in the centre of town, a 10-minute journey by car or taxi to the Cenex offices. There is a bus route direct from the station to Holywell park, please see below.



#### By bus

The University Kinchbus sprint service travels between the University and Loughborough train station throughout the day. You will need to get the bus to the Holywell Park stop, and walk straight down Holywell Way towards the car park. Holywell Building is located behind the conference centre on the right hand side. Bus journey approximately 20 minutes



#### ♣ By air

Holywell park is just 8 miles from East Midlands Airport and convenient for Birmingham International Airport via the M42. Airport is a 15-minute drive to Cenex

# Visiting Cenex

Anyone visiting Cenex and parking in the University car parks will have to pay visitor parking charges. The visitor parking charges are:-



Monday to Friday - up to 2 hours - £1.00

Monday to Friday - up to 4 hours - £2.00

Monday to Friday - Full day - £4.00

Evenings (Monday to Friday) - from 6.00pm to 8.00am - £1.00

Saturday & Sunday - up to 24 hours - £1.00

Enforcement will be through on-site traffic officers issuing tickets for parking outside designated bays and through the ANPR cameras which will automatically send Parking Charge Notices (PCNs) to vehicles that have entered the site but do not have a valid permit or have not registered/paid as a visitor through the systems provided.
